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Why Slovenia?

Slovenia is a highly industrialised, export-oriented EU economy recognised for engineering excellence, innovation, advanced manufacturing and strong integration into European value chains. The delegation brings together companies active in artificial intelligence, digitalisation, advanced manufacturing, energy technologies, sustainable construction, scientific systems engineering, utilities and defence-related industries.

Strategic Location & Connectivity

Slovenia sits at the crossroads of major European transport and trade routes, offering the shortest link between the Adriatic Sea and Central Europe. Quality infrastructure includes the Port of Koper, more than 700 km of motorways, over 39,000 km of road network, more than 1,300 km of railways, and Ljubljana Airport.

Innovation & Engineering Strength

Slovenia is a Central and Eastern European leader in the number of "hidden champions" - highly specialised companies that are global leaders in their niche markets, built on engineering excellence, strong industrial heritage and an innovation-driven workforce. The business environment is supported by a competitive tax regime: 22% corporate income tax, 100% tax deduction on R&D expenses, and 40% tax deduction on tangible and intangible investment assets, with incentives that can be carried forward for up to five years.

Slovenia - Czech Republic Trade

Total bilateral goods trade between Slovenia and the Czech Republic reached €2.04 billion in 2025, making the Czech Republic Slovenia's 13th most important trading partner overall. Slovenian exports to the Czech Republic are traditionally led by electrical machinery and equipment, pharmaceuticals and machinery, while imports are led by vehicles and automotive parts, electrical machinery and machinery. The relationship is underpinned by a Free Trade Agreement and a double-taxation treaty, providing a stable and predictable framework for business.

The delegation is organised by SPIRIT Slovenija, the Slovenian Business Development Agency, in cooperation with the Slovenian Ministry of the Economy, Labour and Sport and the Embassy of the Republic of Slovenia in Prague. The central event is the business forum "Slovenia and the Czech Republic: Forging Partnership in Advanced Technology Sectors", held on Tuesday, 22 September 2026, with participation of high-level officials including the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of the Economy, Labour and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia, Dr Anže Logar, and the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Industry and Trade of the Czech Republic, Dr Karel Havlíček, alongside representatives of chambers of commerce, ministries and development institutions from both countries.

The programme includes thematic roundtables on smart mobility & logistics and ICT & AI in industry, B2B matchmaking meetings, a networking lunch with the Slovenian Tourist Board focused on congress tourism, and an evening reception hosted by the Embassy of the Republic of Slovenia in Prague. A visit to a selected Czech company or additional business meetings is planned for Wednesday, 23 September 2026.
